Tidewater's Umatilla Terminal is located on the Oregon side of the Columbia River just upstream of the McNary Dam. This facility handles, stores and blends various fuels and fertilizers. Products received by barge are stored on site and dispatched by truck.

The Terminal is accessible by barge and Union Pacific rail tracks. Oregon State Highway 730 serves this terminal Directly, and Interstate Highways 82 and 84 are adjacent.
